



Pinetop-Lakeside's
Community Development Department requests public input regarding the
Town's General Plan

On August 5, 2010, the Town Council established a resolution to begin the statutory 60-day review period for the General Plan. State Statutes requires a 60-day review period, during which time comments are received from specified agencies and the general public. Therefore, the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside will host a series of public open-house meetings during the 60-day review period in which the Planning and Zoning Commission will review elements of the General Plan.

Public involvement is an integral part of the General Plan process. The Plan represents a ten-year framework to guide growth, so it must reflect community values and goals.

A series of four public meetings will take place in the months of August, September and October, 2010 during the regularly scheduled Planning & Zoning Commission meetings. All public meetings will be held in the Town Hall Council Chambers to discuss the General Plan.

The process is ongoing and public participation and feedback are encouraged to assist the Town's planning efforts to better serve the needs and desires of the community.
