Agenda No. 1: Welcome and Introduction: Mayor Smith welcomes everyone to the meeting and introduces Sara Gomez and Clark Terril as the newest members. All members present.


Approval of Minutes from Meetings of November 17, 2009, November 24, 2009, and December 3, 2009: Tyler Lacey motions to approve the minutes and Emery Real Bird seconds. Motion passes unanimously. There are no discrepancies found in the Minutes.

Agenda No. 3: Discussion and Decision of MYAC Walk for Woodland: Reid Dempsey suggests that MYAC holds their own walk for Woodland separate from the Town Walk. Bryce Pyper, Emily Yost, and Desiree McKee disagree and say that it would be too difficult to set one up so late. Emery Real Bird points out the difficulties of attracting youth to the Woodland Walk and MYAC agrees to host it before graduation, if possible. Emily Yost asks MYAC if they want to take over the Town Walk completely, and they decide not to but do agree to take over the responsibility of advertising to the town youth and helping to set up the actual day. Kelsey Rugaard mentions that the Humane Society wants to host its own walk and Emily Yost agrees it would be feasible. Tyler Lacey motions to add further discussion of the mural and Humane Society walk at the next meeting, and Desiree McKee seconds. The motion passes unanimously.

Agenda No. 4: Recap of MYAC presentations: MYAC once again agrees that the presentations were successful and helped the Town Council to have a youth prospective on things. Ben Newman says that they will need the Town Council to help with any independent goals MYAC may have. Emily Yost agrees.
